

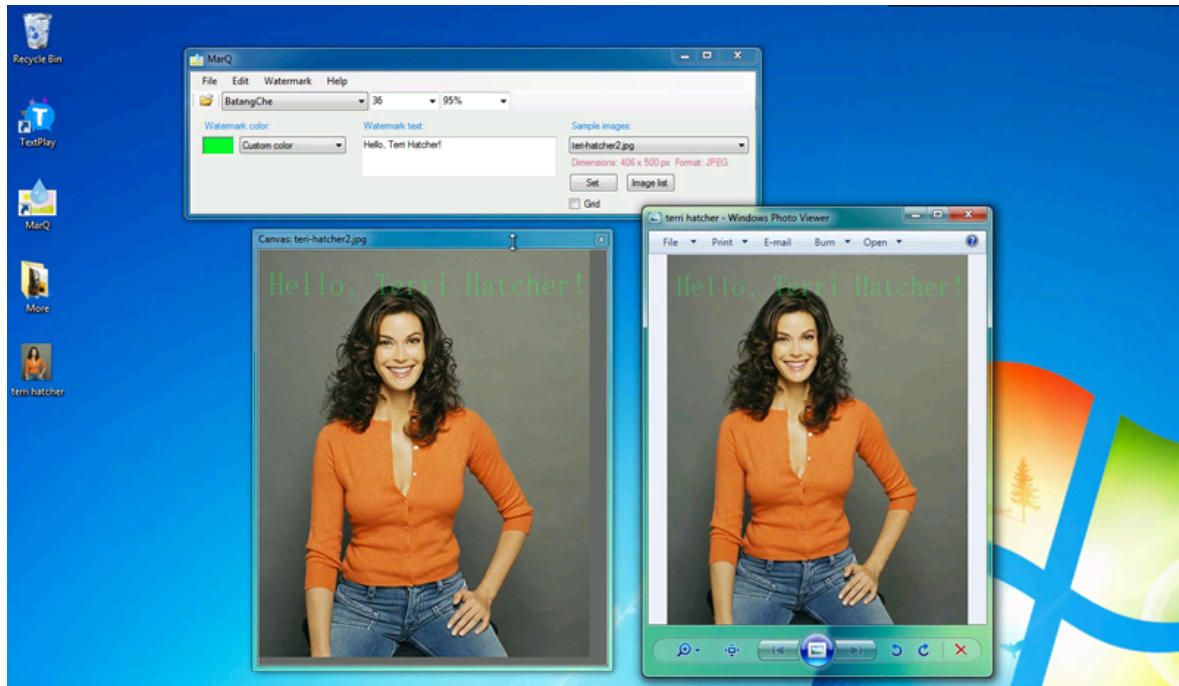
# MarQ



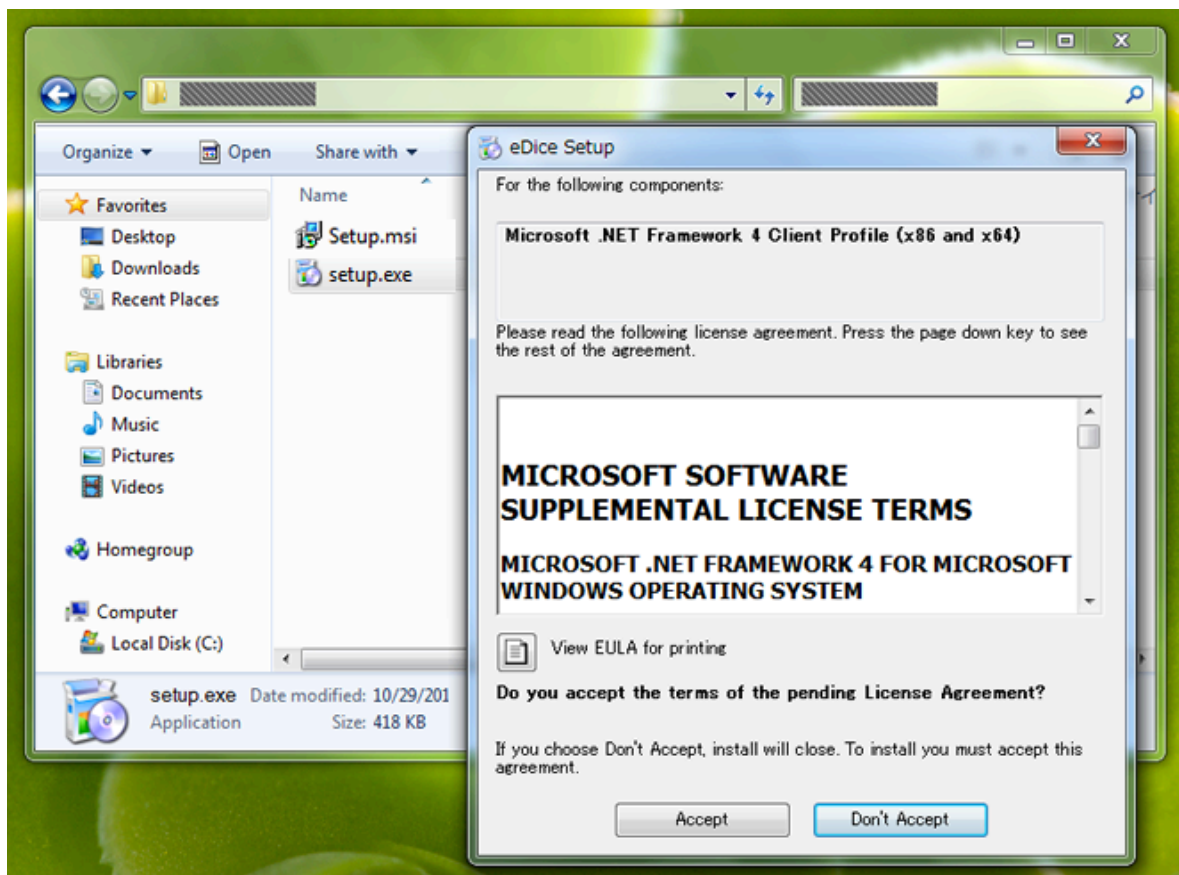

## 1. Introduction

**MarQ** is a simple Windows application that you can use to watermark images with text. All you have to do is open a file, select font, text size, opacity, text color and the image to work on from the drop-down menu. Then click on the Set button to open Canvas to view the picture. You can pan and manually position watermark text on Canvas. Finally, choose Export to save a final watermarked picture.



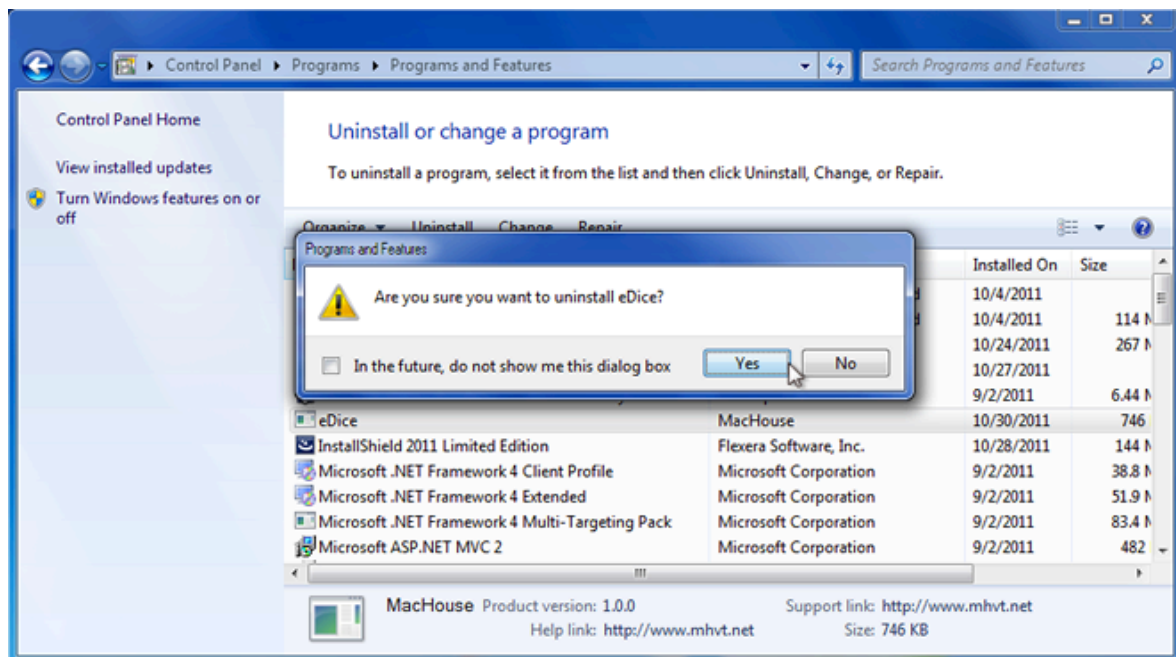

## 2. Installing MarQ

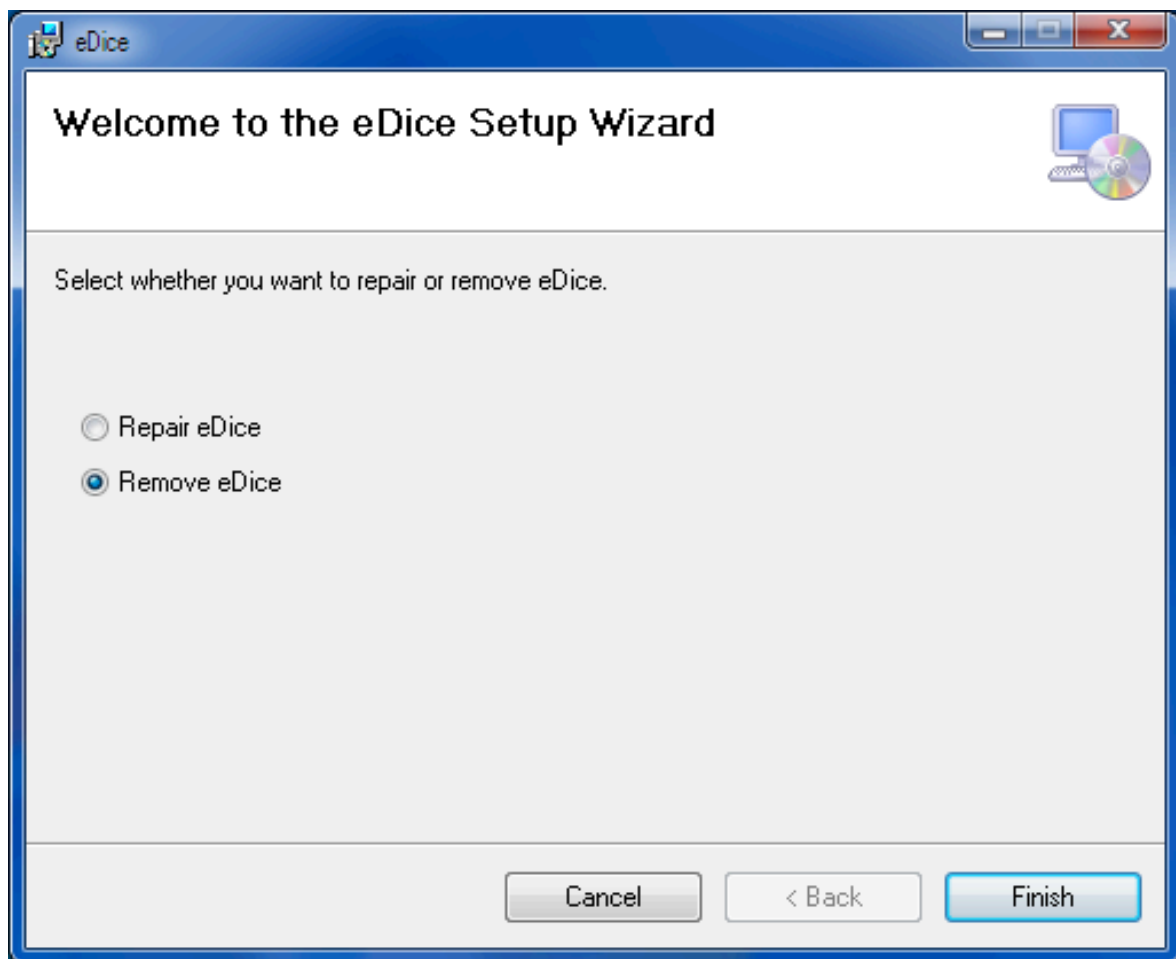
Double-click on **setup.exe** in the delivery package initiate the installation process. If your computer doesn't have it yet, MarQ will first attempt to install **.NET Framework 4**, and you will be prompted for confirmation. (See Screenshot 2.) Then you will proceed to install MarQ. You can use **Setup.msi** to install the application as long as you already have .NET Framework 4, which MarQ requires. You can find the application at the following path: C:\Program Files (x86)\MacHouse\MarQ.

## 3. Uninstalling MarQ

Open Control Panel and choose Uninstall a program. Then double-click on MarQ to initiate the uninstalling process. (See Screenshot 3.) You can also use the original setup.exe or setup.msi to uninstall the application. (See Screenshot 4.)

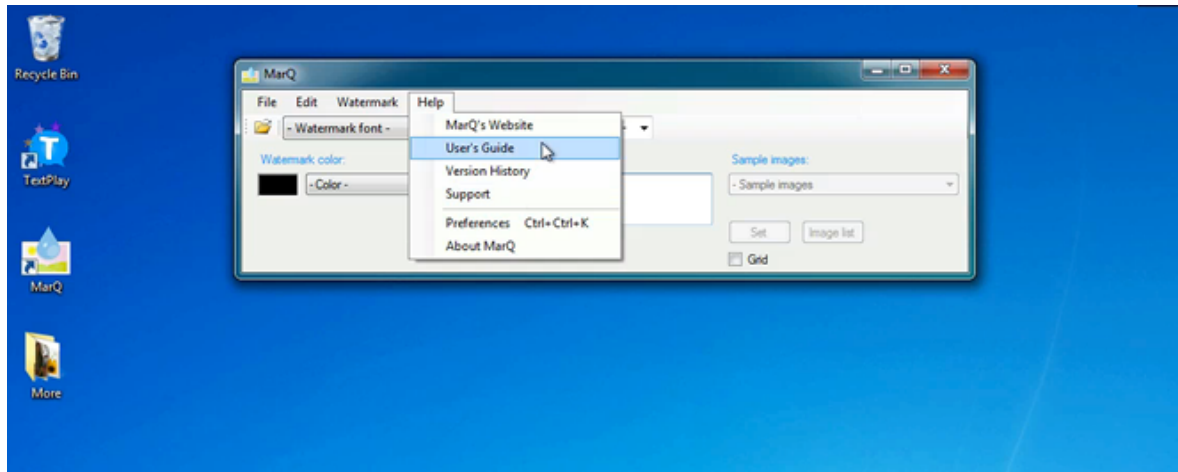
